



**Scholarship Criteria for High School Class of 2020
(North Cobb High School/Allatoona High School/North Cobb
Christian School/Cornerstone Preparatory)**

Deadline for Submission is April 3,2020

The Save Acworth History Foundation Scholarship Committee will award up to four one time non-renewable **\$1000** scholarships to graduating seniors who have demonstrated a strong interest in history and are planning to major in or pursue the study of history in a full-time accredited college or university in the United States. Applicants must have a 3.25 GPA. Scholarships will be awarded to students chosen from the above named high schools.

Requirements:

1. Student must write an essay of 500 words or less, double-spaced, sharing what aspect of history is of interest to him/her.
2. The essay must list the student's extracurricular activities, honors, volunteering, recognition, awards, and community involvement.
3. The student must indicate the colleges or schools to which he/she has applied and/or been accepted.
4. The student must name the course of study that he/she plans to pursue, and list aspirations and goals that are hoped to be achieved.
5. One letter of recommendation by high school teacher or school administrator must be included.
6. Each submission must be accompanied by the Scholarship Application Form.
7. Submission of completed Essay and Application Form must be received via email to:
